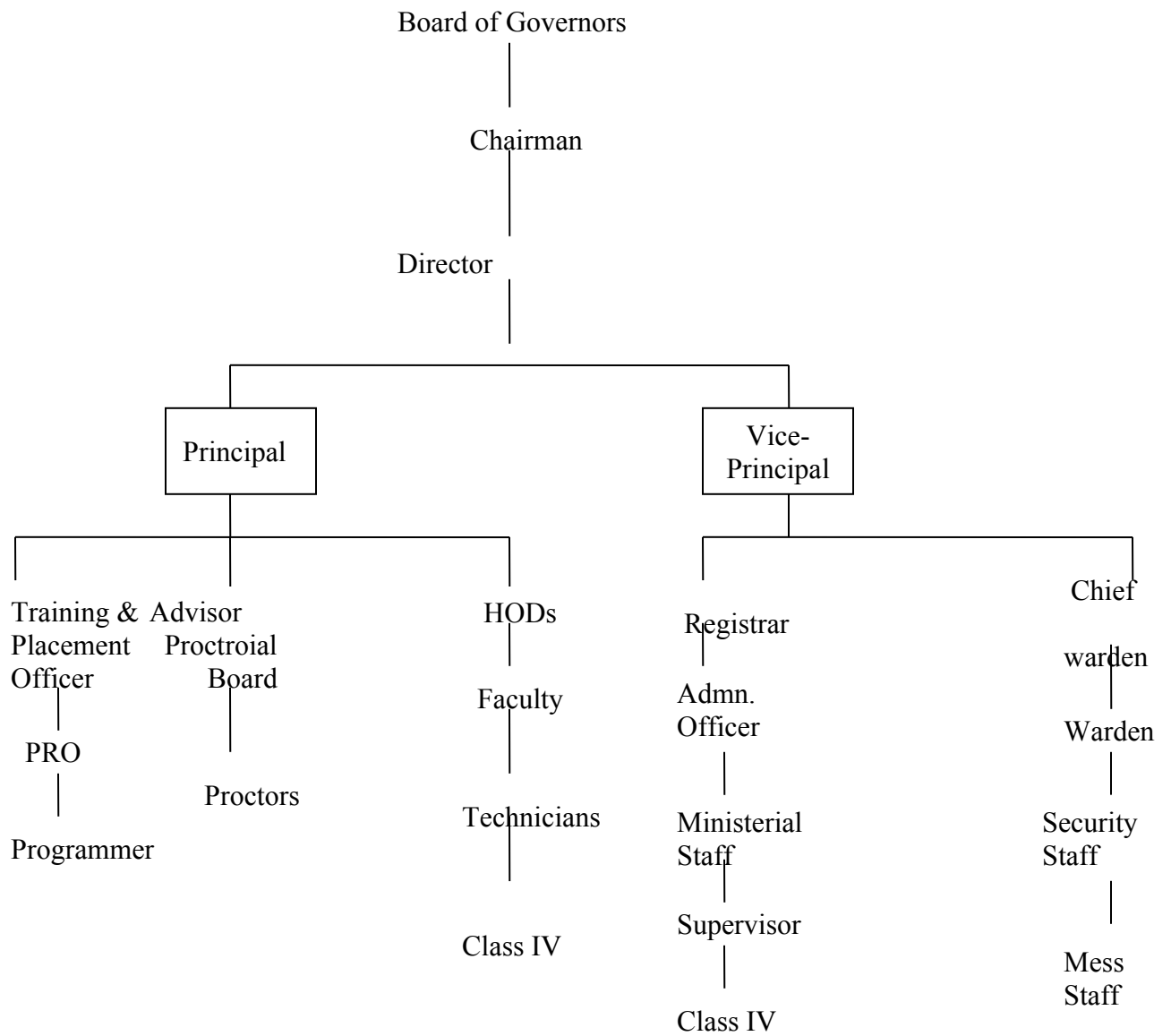
❖ **Frequency of the Board Meetings and Academic Advisory Body**

Normally board meets two times in each semester to finalise development programmes but finance committee of Board of Governors meets every month.

Meeting of the advisory committee is scheduled once every semester to discuss academic progress and also to finalise proposal for change in syllabus to be submitted to Board of studies, Rajasthan Technical University.

❖ **Nature and Extent of involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs/improvements**

To achieve academic excellence following methodology is adopted in this Institute

1. After a faculty member is appointed, he is subjected to in house training in teaching skills under the personal supervision of Principal/Director.
2. Before starting a subject every faculty member is required to submit a Time Framed Time Table for the subject/subjects, he is teaching with dates with respect to various milestones in the syllabus. Head of the department monitors compliance to TFFT. If a faculty member is behind schedule extra periods are allotted to him/her.
3. Actual class room teaching is continuously evaluated. To achieve this Principal/Director attends classes along with HOD/invited subject expert. Based on this teacher is advised. Close circuit TV provides access to lecture rooms to facilitate the director to see the performance from his seat.
4. Every faculty member is required to submit notes in the library and process for making these available on LAN is in progress. Every faculty member prepares a question bank of University level questions and also objective questions for the benefit of students. These notes and question bank is continuously up graded.
5. Students are evaluated with the help of short attention test after finishing a topic in syllabus and if the general lack of understanding in some article is observed it is revised in the class before starting next topic.
6. Faculty is encouraged to attend seminar/work shop/ summer school to improve their teaching skills.
7. Students are encouraged to discuss their difficulties in academic matters with the Counselor, faculty and Head of the Department.
8. All matters related to discipline are reported to advisor proctorial board by the proctors.
9. Faculty is encouraged to persue higher education and incentives are given for acquiring higher degree.
10. Heads of the department hold regular meetings of departmental council and discuss academic progress.
11. Daily record of lectures delivered and experiments conducted is maintained by Advisor Proctorial Board and he is assisted by the Proctors.

12. Students are encouraged to participate in paper writing, software and hardware intercollegiate competitions.
13. In house personality improvement programme is run by the faculty for all students. It is a well designed sequential programme starting from second B.E.

❖ **Mechanism/Norms & Procedure for democratic/good Governance**

At Rajasthan Institute of Engineering & Technology system is transparent and good opportunity is provided to faculty, staff and students to discuss their problems with the authority. However, he/she has to follow the hierarchy. Every body is permitted to meet the highest authority if his/her problem is not solved at lower level.

❖ **Student Feedback on Institutional Governance/faculty performance**

1. Feed back from the students is taken before end of the semester to assess the performance of the faculty and based on this necessary reformative measures are taken.
2. Parent-Teacher association exists in the college where parents are invited once every semester as per pre intimated programme to discuss all problems of the students with the faculty and HOD. To ensure good attendance PTA meetings are held on second Saturday.
3. Alumni association has also been formed to maintain continuous interaction with old students and to have unbiased feed back.
4. Students are encouraged to form literary and cultural society and sports and athletics club.

For redressal of grievances of faculty member has to first reports to his HOD. In most cases grievances are settled within the department, if not faculty member or Technical staff can appeal to Principal/Director. In rare cases it is required to refer the case to the Board by Director/Principal. For other staff the order is Adman officer/ Registrar, Vice-Principal, Principal and finally Board of Governors, pending meeting of the Board of Governors, Chairman is authorized to take and decision which he reports to the Board of Governors when ever next meeting is convened .

Students - For students grievance redressal system has following hierarchy.

- Student
- Tutor / Guardian
- Warden ( for hostellers) / chief warden
- Proctor / Head of the Department
- Principal / Director
- Board of Governors through Director

20 students are put under the charge of one faculty member who monitors their progress and provides counseling to enable him to solve his problems. For hostellers the tutor takes help from the warden also.

If tutor and warden are not able to solve the problem of a student his case is referred to Head of the Department. Head of the Department takes assistance from the Proctorial board. In rare cases matter is referred to Principal / Director who may refer it to Board of Governors if necessary.

❖ **Number of scholarship offered by the institute, duration and amount**

- a. The Management has announced merit cum means scholarship of Rs.2,10,000/- per annum in the memory of Late Smt. Chandrawatiji for economically weaker but scholarly students. It has also resolved to give free ship to students hailing from BPL families and one student was given free ship for the entire course from the year 2006-07.
- b. A limited number of merit cum means scholar ship are sanctioned by the management for meritorious students and if he/she continues to score more than 75 percent marks in University examination it is continued for all four years. Amount of scholarship is Rs.50,000/- per annum.

❖ **Criteria for fee waivers/scholarship.**

- a. For Scholarship – A student who comes from a poor family and has scored more than 80% marks in secondary and more than 75% marks in senior secondary is eligible for a scholarship of Rs.5000/- per annum. He will have to maintain 75% marks for continuation of scholarship for subsequent years. Free ship is admissible for a candidate coming from a family below poverty line (BPL).
- b. For scholarship in the memory of Late Smt. Chandrawatiji a committee comprising of Registrar and two heads of the departments review the received application and sanction the scholarship.

❖ **Estimated cost of Boarding and Lodging in Hostels.**

At present cost of boarding and lodging is. Rs.39,000/- per annum for triple seated room, Rs. 43,000/- per annum for double seated room and Rs.50,000/- per annum for single seated room.
